

CULTIVATED PLANTS

1. Antirrhinum majus Linn.

This plant is cultivated in the Gardens of the hilly regions. It is also sometimes noticed as Garden escapes.

2. Calceolaria mexicana Benth.

This plant is noticed in the Gardens of the Darjeeling District and also occurs as Garden escapes within the hilly regions.

3. Digitalis purpurea Linn.

A cultivated plant of medicinal importance. It yields the alkaloid 'Digitalin'. For the alkaloid, the plant is cultivated in the hilly regions.

4. Russelia equisetiformis Cham. & Schlecht

Cultivated in the Gardens, both in the plains and hills, within the area. Flowers are showy and are in bloom throughout the year.
