A copy of letter No. GCT. dated 27th December, 1960 from the Principal, The Indian Railways, School of Signal Engineering and Telecommunications, Secunderabad -17 addressed to the writer.

The additional information required by you is given below:-

Item No. 1. The theoretical subjects taught in this institution pertain to the technical equipments only and no additional subjects are taught.

Item No. 2. The total period of training for the Apprentices vary from one year to three years, the full details of which may be obtained from various railways. The nine months course in this institution is part of the total training period and they obtain special training in office, line and workshops after they leave this institution.

Item No. 3. The refresher courses for Signal & Telecom. Inspectors cover a period of four months and for Officers two months. The subjects are the same as for initial trainees, but will be dealt in different depths. The officers have to prepare a monograph on a subject chosen by them.

The refresher course for Draftsmen is for a period of six months and the subjects dealt with are shown in the enclosed list.
