

GLOSSARY

Coromandel	- Refers to Eastern Coast of India covering the coast of Orissa, Andhra Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu.
Conseils de Prudhommes	- Council of Experts, which has the characteristics of a court.
Coutume de Paris	- Custom of Paris, which may be termed as Customary Law of France.
Droit Ecrit	- Written Law or Codified Law.
Deepavali	- Name of a festival celebrated throughout India.
Kijeour	- Name of a place which is situated at about 8 km away from Pondicherry.
Manimekalai	- A Tamil Classic.
Mirasdar	- Land Owner.
Panéal	- Workers' Leader (Gangman).
Pathupattu	- Ten Idylls - Tamil Poems composed about two thousand years ago.
Pattinapalai	- It is a Tamil Poem composed about two thousand years ago. It is said to be one of the Poems from 'Pathu Pattu'.
Perumbanarrupada	- Tamil Poem composed about two thousand years ago.
Pongal	- Name of a festival in Tamil Nadu.
Process Verbal	- Official Report or Proceedings.
Reconventional Petitions	- Extra-ordinary or Special Petitions.



Silappadikaram	- Tamil Literary work, which literally means 'the lay of the anklet'.
Sangam Period	- The period when 'Sangam dynasty ruled certain parts of Southern India. It is believed that the period extended upto sixth century.
Syndicate Organization	- Trade Union,
Tamilagam	- Refers to Territory, where Tamil was the spoken language of the people. Territory included Pondicherry.
Talaiyari	- Supervisor.
Yavanas	- Craftsmen originally belonging Greece/Rome and found in southern part of India.
