

CHAPTER IX

ATTITUDINAL TRANSFORMATION OF FAMILY OF SUICIDEE

The views on suicidal attempts and verbal or other communications of suicidal intent as efforts, however misdirected, to solve problems of living, as frantic pleas for help and hope from other people: help in solving the problems, and hope that they can be solved. A person commits suicides when his life becomes totally meaningless. It is our conviction that an implicit or explicit fear or expectation of suicide is most often communicated by a hopeless, helpless response, and that this communication is important in facilitating suicide. Suicide is both planned and unpremeditated, suicidal tendency is a symbol of internal distatures, mental disequilibrium and deep rooted frustration. Attitude towards suicide varies greatly from one society to another. For example the early Greek's considered suicide an appropriate solution to many stressful situations, such as dishonor, disappointment in love and painful conditions. It is the view that "society can play a similar role with regard to suicide. Some desperately troubled, "marginal" individuals communicate explicitly – and we do not know why their consideration of the alternative of suicide; others do not. Nevertheless, "society's expectations are crucial in defining the choice of identity. In this chapter the researcher tried to analyze the attitudinal transformation of family before and after one committing suicide.

The table shows the younger age groups never ever thought that suicide could degrade the family status. They realized that suicide can degrade the status of the family and they understood the intensity only after a suicide attempt in the family. They did not fear about suicide youngsters never feared about this incident. They disagree that suicide may occur any where and at any time. Some believed that family members are fully responsible for the suicide. If they extend a helping hands to members it would never happen. Now the respondents realized certain things were out of the control of the family. Some suicides are due to sudden impulse of the suicidee. They disagree that suicide may occur any where and at any time. The suicide occurs when life is under a problematic situation. Most of the respondents believe that healthy family atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide to a great extent. The youngsters partially agree that suicides make bitter experience in life. They believed that only arrogant and selfish people commits suicide. They believed if one committed suicide, the lose was to himself alone, but now they can understand it is lose to the whole family and also to the society. The respondent in the younger age group believed introvert behaviour is the reason for this tragedy. If one can open his heart with dear one it never happens. The youngsters could only partially agree suicide is not a solution to life. They believed earlier that suicide can offer solution to problems in life. It will be the end of all problems but after they realized that not an end in itself but beginning of problems in life. Youngsters practically agree that mental health is more important. The respondent in the age group 40-50 believed mental health is more important. Before committing suicide most of the respondents felt nuclear family system act as the main cause to this tragedy. The weakening of

relations within the nuclear families leads to the tragedy. They believed in depth faith in God can solve the problems in life.

While analyzing the relation between age and attitude of family members, the respondents in the age group 30-40 and 40-50 highly felt after the suicide of their dear one the family status has highly degraded due to suicidal death of the family member. The respondents in the age group of 30-40 and 50-60 invariably agree that suicide can occur any where at any time. Now a days the respondents believed that imbalance in the family even in single matters are unbearable to family members beyond any caste, age, sex religion and region. They believed suicide can occur any where at any time. The Lion share of the respondents in the age group of 40-50 completely agree that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide. But the respondents in the age group of 30-40 and 50-60 find it hard to agree that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide. The respondents in the age group of 30-40 and 40-50 agree without any doubt that suicide makes bitter experience in life. It can only give humiliation, degradation, isolation shame. The respondents in the age group of 30-40 and 50-60 believe that the introvert behaviour of the suicidee is the reason for becoming the situation vulnerable but the respondents in the age group of 40-50 believed that not only the introvert behaviour of the person but also the heavy alcoholism, suspicious nature and quarrelling tendency are the major reasons for making the situation more vulnerable. The respondents in the younger age group believed that suicide is not a solution to problems in life. The respondents in the age group of 40-50 and 50-60 believed that when the pain exceeds suicide is the only one

solution to life. When life is filled with agony or it become hopeless, suicide becomes a better solution.

Before the family member's commit suicide more female members believed suicide degrades the family status. They did not much fear about this incident. They couldn't agree suicide can occur any where at any time. More female members were believed that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide. They knew that suicide only makes bitter experience in life especially for women. She has to face humiliation, degradations, alienation and exclusion not in the social setting also from the family itself. Half of them can agree that suicide is not solution to life; it can only increase personal grief. To some were believed if is an end in itself, so it can solve the problems in life. More female respondents believed mental health is more important than societal and family environment. They agree that nuclear family system is the

main cause of this tragedy, which means the increasing individualization among members.

The table shows most of the female respondent felt their family status has highly degraded after committing suicide; they feared about this incident, they believed suicide may occur anywhere at any time, even though family concern about the suicidee increase alcoholism, illicit relation and problem of adjusting to change in situation with family may also contribute reason for suicide. They partially agree that healthy atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide. The respondents believed that even though the family gives love and support to these respondents they failed to cope with change in family relations. The family gave advice to and tries to properly chanalise properly their activities. If these advices fell into deaf ears then the family is helpless. They felt that suicide only could make bitter experiences in life. After the suicide of the family member the life of others become miserable due to gossiping and rumors. Their lives are filled with isolation and humiliation. They partially agree that introvert behaviour of the suicidee is the reason for this tragedy. They understood that suicide is not a solution to the problems of life. It can only help to increase personal grief. Suicide is not solution to life. It can only increase difficulties and miseries of life. Through suicide the member alone escapes from painful life, but throws others into long grief. The female respondents said that the mental health of the person is more important than family and societal environment. Family sometimes fails to interfere with the problems of members. If an individual has capacity to solve problem himself that is he/she is capable for taking alternative mechanism to solve problems of life, it can help to reduce the occurrence of suicide. Most female

respondents disagree that nuclear family system is not the reason for this tragedy. They also partially agree that in depth faith in God can solve problems in life. Men take initiative to solve problems in life. They couldn't ignore the magical presence of Almighty.

While correlating the marital status and attitude of family before one commits suicide, it was observed that most of the widowers know suicide can degrade the family status. Most of the widowers and the married did not come across fear much about suicide before one committing it in the family. Most of them could not imagine such a disaster would happen to their family. Most of the respondents believed that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide and whenever suicide occurs they know family had to face humiliation and ill-treatment not only from society but even from the family members. The widowers believed that introvert behaviour of the

suicidee is the main cause for this situation becoming vulnerable. But married and unmarried believed introvert behaviour is not only one cause for suicide and many cases were believed some people commit suicide due to the arrogant behavior and aggressive nature. A significant percentage of them believed that the nuclear family system is the main cause for suicide. The respondents believed that indepth faith in God can solve the problems in life and a small percentage partially agreed to this statement. They believed that even though people have indepth faith in God, things will happen what is destined to happen.

The table shows that the widows felt their family status to be highly degraded after the suicidal death of the family. They felt that people were looking down upon them. When they go out, people whispered and murmured. In certain families people hesitated to have alliance with. When they attended marriage parties or ceremonies they felt they were alienated in the group. People doubted about this incident and raised queries about it. They believed suicide can occur any where at any time. The widows felt that if the members themselves have the support mechanism to solve the problems they can prevent suicide. They can only partially agree that introvert behaviour of the suicide is the cause for this tragedy. But the aggressive nature, fear and revenge to family end in suicide. They completely agree that it is not a solution to problems in life. Mental health by respondents such as problem solving skills, capacity to cope with changing situations, optimism about life and cultivating of values within the family, can reduce problems in the life. They completely believe God can solve the problems in life.

Occupation and attitude of family before and after one committing suicide

The researcher explains the relation between occupation and attitude of the family members after suicide. The table shows that many house wives felt their family status being highly degraded and they were suffered from the feeling of fear. People in the all occupational categories indiscriminately believed suicide may occur any where any time, but some housewives responded that quarrels and misunderstanding between family members was the main villain of suicide. The self employed believed that healthy family atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide and housewives commonly agree that healthy family relations are not individual concern but it is the responsibility of all members. All most all respondents indiscriminately agree suicide can only make bitter experiences in their life - gossiping, hallucinations, fear, guilty, grief and above all weakening family relation. The housewives felt that the introvert behaviour of the deceased is the main cause of this tragedy. Others said that they have given indirect warnings but the family didn't pay much attention to these warnings. Lionshare of the respondents agreed with whole heartedly suicide is not a solution for problems in life. Even now some believed when the life is at cross roads suicide is only one solution than living with difficulties. Most of the respondents agree that nuclear family system is not the reason for this tragedy. They said the relationship among members are more important than the family size.

The respondents from all occupational categories know suicide can degrade family status. The small percentage of house wives and coolie workers and majority of the self employed did not feared about the suicide but after the suicide of family

member they were much not feared about suicide than before. But after this incident they were much feared about suicide. The feeling of shock and fear and unwanted thoughts haunted their life. Most of the respondents believed that suicide may occur any where at any time. They completely and partially agree that suicide may occur any where at any time. They believed that healthy family atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide. Before the occurrence of suicide some of the housewives, self employed and coolie workers never thought of it before occurrence of suicide and agree half heartedly that suicide only can make bitter experience in life most of the housewives were believed that generally withdrawal tendency of suicides if a person can open heart with others they can share problems with others which can reduce the occurrence of suicide and they also believed mental health is more important than family and societal environment. Before the occurrence of suicide lion share of the respondents believed that nuclear families are the main reasons for this tragedy. The people completely agree that in depth faith in God can solve the problems of life.

Religion and attitude of family before and after one committing suicide

The table shows Christian and Muslims felt more than Hindus that suicide can degrade the family status. Hindus do not fear about suicide than Christians and Muslims. Even though superstitions and taboos were dominant among Hindus. They do not show much fear about suicide. Most of the respondents disagree that suicide can occur any where at any time. They partially agreed that healthy family can reduce the risk of suicide. A notable percentage of Hindus were disagreed that suicide can occur any where at any time. More Hindus and Christians partially agree that healthy

family atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide at great extent. More Hindus disagree that introvert behaviour is the main cause for becoming the situation more vulnerable. About half of the respondents believed suicide is not a solution to problems in life. Except Muslims from the people in the other religious category believed that mental health is more important than family and societal environment and most of them strongly believe that in depth faith in God can solve the problems in life but Hindus believed God is only guide to the problematic situation in our life.

The table shows most of the respondents from almost all religions agree that their family status degraded due to the suicidal death of a family member, Muslims more affected because it was not common in their community. The whole blame fell in the family members. The respondents from all religious community feared about it but Muslims were not much feared than others. More Christians and Muslims opined suicide may occur any where at any time. But some respondents from Hindu community believed individual and family disorganization are the risk factors of suicide. More Hindus and Christians opined suicide makes bitter experience in their life. Due to less interference of religious leaders and institutions on family Muslims didn't feel suicide is not bitter experience. The respondents from all religious groups do not agree introvert behaviour is main reason for making the situation vulnerable. The significant percentage of respondents whole heartedly agrees that suicide is not solution to the problems in life. But a small percentage believed suicide is an end in itself and it is the channel escapism to the suicidee. Except small percentage of respondents in the Hindus community all respondents completely agree mental health of the suicidee more important than family and societal environment. All the

respondents opined nuclear family system is not the only reason for this tragedy. About half of the respondents believed that in depth faith in God helps to face complexities and problems in life and some were belief in God not alone solve problem but man should take care of themselves.

Type of family and attitude of family members

Before one committing suicide most of the respondents in the nuclear families believed that if suicide occurs in a family it degraded the family status. Only small percentage of the respondents believed suicide did not degrade their family status. Most of the respondents in the extended families do not entertain much fear about this incident. Many members in the extended families believed suicide may not be occurred every where. The families which lack the social support and the members not much cared about the well being of other members have the chance for suicide. Most of the members in the nuclear families believed that the introvert behaviour of the deceased is the main cause of suicide and about half of the respondents believed suicide is solution to the problems in life and for some it is the gateway to problems in life. Some believed it is not a solution to problems in life it can only give measurable loss to family. They believed that mental health is more important than family and societal environment. The respondents believed that nuclear family system is the reason for this tragedy. They commonly agreed that in depth faith in God can solve the problems in life.

After one committing suicide most of the respondents belonging to nuclear families opined their family status highly degraded after the suicidal death of the beloved one. It filled in them a feeling of shame and people showed difficulty to

mingle with them. They feared about this incident. They agreed suicide may occur any where at any time. They believed that in nuclear families due to strong bond between family members, there is less chance for suicide. They can partially agree that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide because different people' reacting to same situation in different in manner even family is willing to listen them. Some resort to alcohol. Most of respondents disagreed that nuclear family system is the reason for this tragedy. They believe what ever may be the size of the family, the relationship and solidarity between family members are more important. They believe in depth belief in God can solve their problems in life.

While analyzing education and attitude of family before one committing suicide the people from low educational background believed that suicide can degrade their family status but people those who have higher education do not feel suicide may not cause degradation to the family status. Most of the respondents disagreed suicide may occur anywhere at anytime. Most of the respondents partially agreed that healthy family atmosphere can reduce occurrence of suicide at a great level. Before the attempt of suicide the family members could not imagine that suicide can only give bitter experience in life. About half of the respondents believed that suicide may be solution to problems in life. Most of the respondents believed that mental health is more important than societal and family environment. People in the low educational background believed that nuclear family system is the cause for this tragedy. Nobody can disagree that in depth faith in God helps to face problems and complexities in life.

While analyzing the educational backgrounds and attitude of the family members after committing suicide. The people from low educational background believed that their family status were highly degraded due to suicidal death of the dear one. They feared about this incident, they were filled with feeling of hallucinations, fear of ghost, fear about death and feeling of insecurity. They believed suicide can occur any where at any time. They believed suicide occur among people those have high education, mainly because they were strained and busy schedule and lack of sharing among them. They think suicide makes only bitter experience in their life, rejection and humiliation from people. They only partially agree that introvert behaviour of the suicidee is the major reason for becoming this situation vulnerable. They said even the suicidee open their heart with family members, the family not take it as a serious. They completely agree that suicide is not a solution to life. It again drove the family did into endless agony. They believe mental health of the suicidee is important. Suicide caused due to inability of the man to cope with bitter experiences in life. They never believed nuclear family system is the cause for this tragedy. They partially agree that in depth faith in God helps to face complexities or problems in life.

The table shows the respondents those belong to the lower income group before one committing suicide believed it can degrade the family status of the

respondents. The respondents in lower income group were not much feared about suicide. They disagreed that suicide may occur any where at any time. They believed indebtedness and economic problems do not alone constitute the cause of suicide and the family can solve the problems within the four walls, which help to reduce suicide. Half of the respondents in the lower income group believed suicide can make only bitter experiences in life and to some bitter experience are relatively common to every body but the way to react with these experiences were entirely different from individual but the respondents in the higher income group believed it surely makes bitter experiences in life. Some of the respondents in the lower income group believed that introvert behaviour of the suicidee is main cause for suicide. A small percentage the respondents even believed suicide can give solution to problems of life. They think it is better to die rather than living in the miserable conditions. About half of the respondents in the lower in come group could agree that mental health of the person is more important than family and societal environment and all other income group completely agree that mental health is more important, which gives capacity to perceive and to understand the problems. The respondents in all income group unanimously believed nuclear family system is one of the main causes of suicide and they agree that in depth faith in God can solve the problems in life.

The respondents who belonged to lower income category believed that their family status highly degraded due to after the suicidal death of beloved one. In addition to their low economic status suicide also degraded their family status. They were more feared about suicide due to the feeling of hallucination and superstitious beliefs and taboos on suicide. They realized suicide occur any where at any time

irrespective of income and family status. They partially agree that healthy family atmosphere can reduce the occurrence of suicide and they believed suicide makes bitter experiences in their life. They did not believe the introvert behaviour of the suicidee is the main cause for this tragedy and they realized that the faith that suicide is not a solution to the problems in life, which again help them from slipping into problems to problems. They believed mental health in more important than family and societal environment. They did not believe nuclear family system is not the only reason for this tragedy but believed that in depth faith in God can solve many problems in life.

The table shows ruralites believed their family status highly degraded after the suicide of the family member. Due to shame and humiliation some respondents think about migration. The queries about the suicidal death from neighbours, even from friends wounded them. They felt the people were looking down upon them. In urban areas people did not interfere with others. They were concerned that about themselves. Ruralites much feared about this incident than urbanites. Ruralites were believed suicide may occur anywhere at any time. Ruralites think relations in the

rural areas are healthier than those of urbanites. They partially agree that healthy family can reduce the occurrence of suicide. Even family gives better atmosphere to an individual. The individual capacity to solve personal problems in life is more important. They believed nuclear family system as reason for this tragedy. They believed that in depth faith in God can help to solve the complexities in life. God alone is the savior in their life. They believed if they give up their problems or complexities to god, he will give guide proper solution to them.

Before the suicide of a family member ruralites and urbanites believed, a suicide can degrade the family status but only a small percentage of ruralites believed. Most of the ruralites were not much feared about suicide. Ruralites were not akin to believe that suicide may occur any where at anytime, but they believed that suicide can occur at stressful life events. Most of them believed that unhealthy family relation is as the cause of suicide among both ruralites and urbanites. They believe suicide makes bitter experience in their life. Most of the ruralites believed introvert behaviour of the suicide in major reason for this tragedy. Most of the respondents were believed suicide is not a solution to all the problems in life. Most of the respondents believed mental health is more important than societal and family environment. Both urbanites and ruralites believed nuclear family system as the reason for this tragedy. Indiscriminately lion share of the respondents believed in depth faith in God can solve the problems in life.

Conclusion

In this chapter the researcher compared the attitudinal transformation of family of those who have committed suicide before and after committing suicide. Before the suicide of family member people knew that it degrades the family status, but after this incident they felt suicide totally degraded the family status. Before one committing suicide the respondents low income group, ruralites believed the chance for occurrence of suicide more among the high income groups and ruralites. But after the occurrence of this incident they realized suicide may occur any where at any time. Before the suicide of the family member they believed healthy family can reduce suicide. But after this incident they understood alcoholism, lack of sharing between family members are the risk factors of suicide. Before this incident they weren't taken into consideration mental health of the suicidee but after it they gave more importance to mental health than family and social environment. The problem solving skill and capacity to perceive changing life situation more prone to suicide. Before this incident they believed introvert behaviour is the main cause for suicide but after this they recognized unidentified clues by the suicide. They believed nuclear family alone comes us the main cause for suicide but after the event they realized that it is not size of the family but the relationship and solidarity among members more important. They believed that in depth faith in God can solve problems in life. Here the researcher proved the hypothesis that "*attitude of the family changed once family member commit suicide*".
